

## Little Church School Covid-19 Prevention Plan

Little Church School will adhere to the following CDC guidelines for childcare facilities.

- Screening children upon arrival. It is imperative that sick children stay home. Any student with a fever or symptoms of illness will be sent home immediately.
- Frequent hand washing for students and staff.
- Teach and reinforce healthy hygiene habits; cover cough and sneezes.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces, toys, and workstations.
- Nonessential adults (including parents) are discouraged from entering the building. We have adequate staff to assist your child to their room and help with their belongings. If a need arises where a parent must enter the building, masks and screening will be required.
- Staff will conduct daily health screenings on themselves.
- Nonessential visitors/presenters will be postponed.
- Staff face coverings will be required during drop-off/pick-up times.
- Social distancing strategies will be implemented as best possible; nap mats will be spaced as far apart as possible during resting time, classes will be separated during chapel time, etc.

LCS plans to remain open regardless of public school closures. In the event that daycares are mandated to close, LCS will adhere to those orders.

If a staff member or student tests positive for Covid-19, LCS will follow CDC guidelines for cleaning/sanitizing and possible short-term closure (2-5 days to be determined by local health officials).
