

Jackson County VOAD hosted a free Hurricane preparation event for the community June 7th.
















Farewell Luncheon for Pastor Kelli Williamson



As a means of continuing education and opportunities for reflection by members of the Finance committee, members had previously agreed to read the book entitled *Generosity, Stewardship and Abundance: A Transformational Guide to Church Finance* by Lovett Weems and Ann A. Michel and to discuss their learnings together at future committee meetings.

Members began discussion of Part 1 of the book. Bill Reaves began discussions by requesting members to reference key points in these first chapters that "stood out" to them as they reviewed the materials. Good discussion ensued and several points in the book were referenced by committee members, some of which include:

- 1. All money talk should begin with the individual's financial position and not with the church's financial position, and reasons to give should always relate to opportunities for individual discipleship and growth of congregation members and not that of the church.
- 2. Reference to the author's rule to "never talk about the church's money apart from the church's mission".
- 3. Discussion of the pros and cons of sharing giving trends of individual members, weighing this information as critical, yet confidential data that can potentially aid a finance committee in understanding the church's fiscal giving patterns and in monitoring necessary income trends associated with the church operating budgets.
- 4. Discussion on finding ways of better "telling the stories", which show the impact that comes from member giving.
- 5. Possibilities of presenting members with more "special giving opportunities" to encourage members' giving for special projects or special memorials, etc.
 - 6. Considering options to enable more on-line giving opportunities.

As time was running out for the meeting, members agreed to adjourn by acclamation and agreed to continue discussions of this section at the next regular meeting.

COWBOY CAVIAR

INGREDIENTS

6 Roma tomatoes, diced 1 bell pepper, seeded & diced

1 medium onion, finely diced 2 jalapeno peppers, seeded & finely diced

1 large avocado, diced 15 oz can corn, drained

15 oz can black beans, rinsed & drained 1/2 bunch of cilantro (about 1/2 cup chopped)

3-4 Tbsp lime juice 1/2 cup Italian Dressing

4 medium garlic cloves, pressed 1 tsp salt or season to taste

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a large mixing bowl, combine diced tomatoes, chopped onion and bell pepper, seeded and diced jalapeno, sliced avocado, drained corn, rinsed and drained black beans and chopped cilantro.
- 2. Stir in 3-4 Tbsp of lime juice, 1/2 cup of Italian dressing, 4 pressed garlic cloves and 1 tsp of salt or season to taste.
- 3. Mix everything together and serve with tortilla chips.
