



Buy a sack of dry (dry only) dog or cat food.

Bring it to church on the 3rd Sunday of each month starting October 15^{th.}
Place food in the foyer of the Wesley Center or Sanctuary in the wagons
Food will be taken to Meals on Wheels People by the Round Table Class
Friends of Elder Citizens will re-sack the food and hand out the pet food when they deliver food in the county.
